June 15th - 19th Dynamic Dinos (Ages 5-12)

Want to look at Dinosaur teeth close up? Become a paleontologist and go on a Dinosaur Dig! You'll investigate the habits, needs, and characteristics of dinosaurs and explore the fossilization process in this fun, hands-on Mad Science camp. It's all about Dinosaurs!



July 6th – 10 Reactions in Action (Ages 5-12)

Campers will get microscopic as they explore the basic building blocks of the universe – atoms and molecules and discover how they interact in interesting combinations. From ooey, gooey slime and movie special effects to how our tongues discern taste, all of our activities involve the three states of matter.



July 20th -24th NASA- Journey into Outer Space (Ages 5-12)

From our Earth's atmosphere to the outer reaches of our solar system, this hands-on program for children sends them on a quest for exploration! Comets, planets, stars and more are all waiting to be discovered. Learn about the four forces of flight, the challenges of space travel, and participate in a rocket launch!
